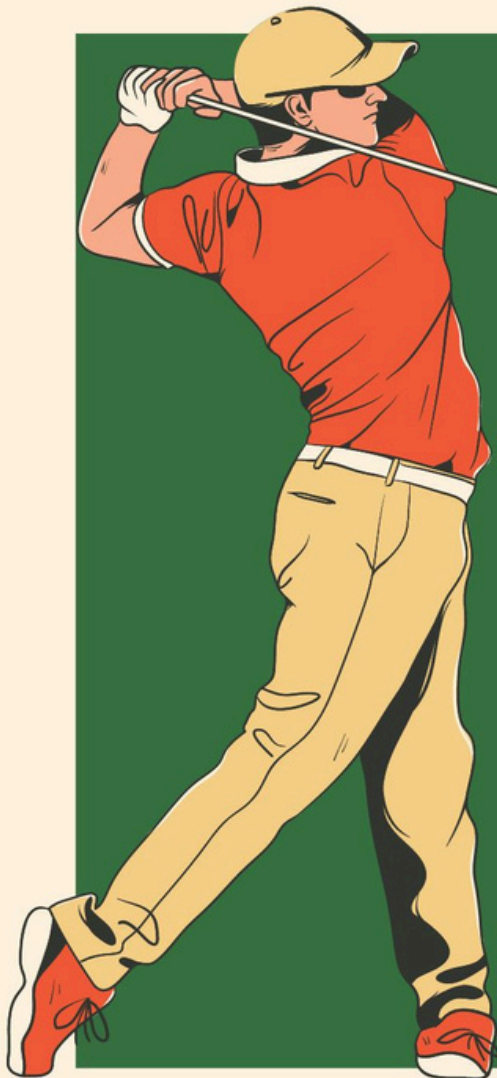

Subject: Proposal to amend By-Laws Article 5 - Dues and Fees, Section A

Dear Toledo Sailing Club ("TSC") Membership,

As part of our ongoing efforts to ensure the financial stability of the TSC, the Board of Directors has conducted a thorough review of our current dues and fees structure. Based on this review, I believe amendments to our by-laws are necessary to align with our financial goals and support our mission.

Article 5, Section A currently reads as follows:

Dues for Active members shall be three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325.00) payable in advance annually. Statements for dues indicating the due date of October 31, shall be mailed to all Active members by the Financial Secretary no less than thirty (30) days in advance of the due date. Statements for other monetary obligations to the Club will be mailed to the member by the Financial Secretary no less than thirty (30) days prior to the due date.

Proposed Change to Article 5, Section A reads as follows:

Dues for Active members shall be four hundred dollars (\$400.00) payable in advance annually. Statements for dues indicating the due date of October 31, shall be mailed to all Active members by the Financial Secretary no less than thirty (30) days in advance of the due date. Statements for other monetary obligations to the Club will be mailed to the members by the Financial Secretary no less than (30) days prior to the due date.

## Changes to By-Laws Need 2 Readings

### ARTICLE 3 – ELECTION TO MEMBERSHIP

A. All applicants for active, life and out-of-State memberships shall sign an application blank provided by the Club for that purpose. **Applications must be signed by two (2) sponsoring Active members of one (1) year standing and be accompanied by a fee consisting of Five hundred twenty-five dollars (\$525.00) covering two hundred dollars (\$200.00) initiation fee and one year's Active member dues.**

#### Proposed

All applicants for active, life and out-of-State memberships shall sign an application blank provided by the Club for that purpose. **Applications must be signed by two (2) sponsoring Active members of one (1) year standing and be accompanied by a fee consisting of Six Hundred Eighty dollars (\$680.00) covering three hundred dollars (\$300.00) initiation fee and one year's Active member dues.**

### ARTICLE 5 - DUES AND FEES

A. **Dues for Active members shall be three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325.00) payable in advance annually.** Statements for dues indicating the due date of October 31, shall be mailed to all Active members by the Financial Secretary no less than thirty (30) days in advance of the due date. Statements for other monetary obligations to the Club will be mailed to the member by the Financial Secretary no less than thirty (30) days prior to the due date.

#### Proposed

**Dues for Active members shall be three hundred eighty dollars (\$380.00) payable in advance annually.** Statements for dues indicating the due date of October 31, shall be mailed to all Active members by the Financial Secretary no less than thirty (30) days in advance of the due date. Statements for other monetary obligations to the Club will be mailed to the member by the Financial Secretary no less than thirty (30) days prior to the due date

### ARTICLE 6 – DOCK AND BOAT REGULATIONS

A. **Members shall be charged an annual fee for docking privileges as follows:**

1. **Docks shall be charged at an annual rate of four dollars (\$4.00) per foot of dock length, plus \$140.00 per dock**

#### Proposed

**Docks shall be charged at an annual rate of four dollars (\$4.00) per foot of dock length, plus \$160.00 per dock**

## ARTICLE 14 – WORK HOURS

A. Except as otherwise stated in the Constitution or these By-Laws, all Active members are required to work twenty (20) hours for the Club per year; provided, work hours performed by a Spousal member shall be credited to the work hour obligation of his or her spouse. **Each Active member who fails to fulfill this obligation will be billed at the rate of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each deficient hour. The work hour program will be administered by a Work Hours Chairman appointed by the Commodore.**

### Proposed

B. Except as otherwise stated in the Constitution or these By-Laws, all Active members are required to work twenty (20) hours for the Club per year; provided, work hours performed by a Spousal member shall be credited to the work hour obligation of his or her spouse. **Each Active member who fails to fulfill this obligation will be billed at the rate of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each deficient hour. The work hour program will be administered by a Work Hours Chairman appointed by the Commodore.**

## Constitution Change Need 3 Readings

### VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS (cont.)

Section 10 - **The Board of Directors shall maintain cash reserves in accounts managed by the Treasurer in the amount of \$25,000 or 10% of the prior year property tax appraisal whichever is greater. The cash reserves may only be used to cover catastrophic, and non-budgeted expenditures in excess of \$10,000 upon approval of the Board of Directors, and a 2/3 vote of the membership.**

### Proposed

Section 10 - **The Board of Directors shall maintain cash reserves in accounts managed by the Treasurer in the amount of \$100,000 or 10% of the prior year property tax appraisal whichever is greater. The cash reserves may only be used to cover catastrophic, and non-budgeted expenditures in excess of \$10,000 upon approval of the Board of Directors, and a 2/3 vote of the membership. The goal is to achieve this by October 31, 2028.**

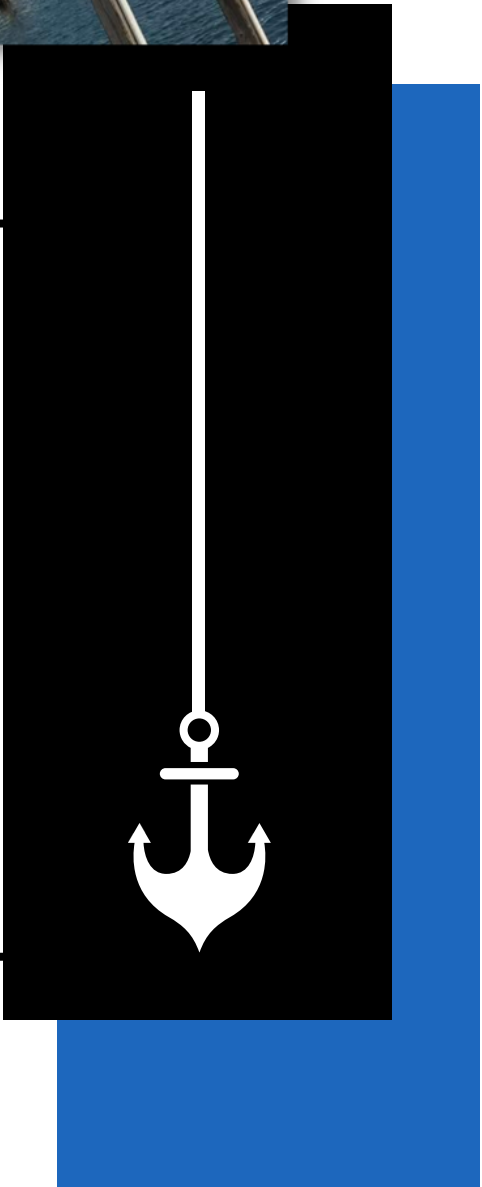

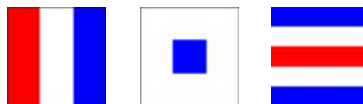
