

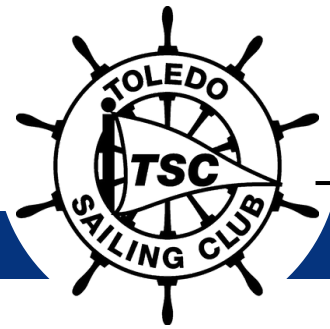


Current Reading of the By-law:


PROPOSED CHANGE TO THE CONSTITUTION

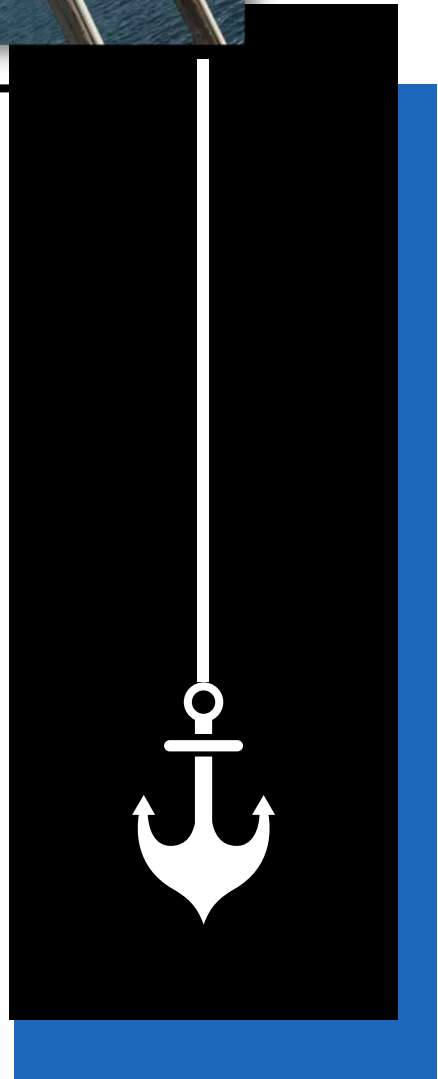

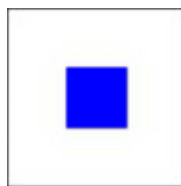
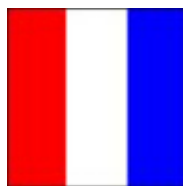
